REPORT OF BALLOT TABULATION – 6/18/2007**

RESULTS:

The results of the ballot tabulation are as follows:



TABULATION PROCEDURE:

There were five people present at the tabulation at the Gallo's house. Two UMCA members Victor Gallo and Bob Barday, along with Gladys Gallo assisted in the tabulation. A Certified Public Accountant, Susan Easterlin, supervised and tabulated and the President of the UMCA, John Lee Ellis, oversaw the procedure.

1. The ballots were compared to each individual membership application. The ballot was signed by the tabulator if there was a match. In the few instances where there was no membership application, the ballot was compared to the membership list and marked as described below.
2. The ballots were compared to the membership list. The ballot was marked with an "M" if there was a match. All ballots matched the "registered to vote" column on the membership list.
3. The ballots were reviewed against the membership list a second time. The members' name was marked with a check to indicate the member had voted. No duplicate ballots were noted.
4. Two ballots were eliminated due to incomplete information; no voter name, address or signature were present on the ballots.
5. No ballots exhibited overvoting or lack of voter registration.
6. The ballots were counted twice. There were 245 ballots, including one which had been mailed erroneously to UMCA HQ, but which did not affect the standings.
7. Gladys read the marked names on the ballots to Victor, Bob and Susan who recorded the vote by marking the candidates' box on the election sheets. Gladys marked each candidates' name on the ballot as she read them out loud.
8. The results for each candidate were tabulated. All three tabulations reconciled.
9. The vote was considered final and complete.
